The Woods at the Luscombe Farm

The Woods at the Luscombe Farm was acquired by the park district as a gift from John H. Luscombe and Ann L. Stine in June of 2016. A dedication and grand opening were held in October of that same year. A small parking lot and kiosk were constructed to give visitors better access to the park. The Luscombe woods have a great variety of trees including maples, hickories, and oaks. It is also a great park to see spring wildflowers like spring beauties, trout lilies, and dutchman's breeches. Old logging trails have been repurposed as an extensive trail system for the 55-acre park. The Woods at the Luscombe Farm is located on County Road 213 outside of Clyde.
